



EATING OUT

There are a number of good restaurants and pubs in the area of the Pfaffenwinkel. We would like to recommend some we have already tested and found good.

There is a good Italian restaurant with outdoor seating in Hohenpeissenberg, the "**Osteria Italiana**" in the Hauptstrasse 22. The "**Bayerischer Rigi**" on top of Hoher Peissenberg mountain is worth visiting if only to see the view from the panorama windows and terrace which can be absolutely breathtaking. This popular restaurant serves Bavarian specialities and cakes. During the week, however, it closes as early as 6pm, on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays not much later, at 8pm. The opening hours of the Bavarian restaurant "**Rigi Alm**" at the Eastern entrance to the village are more convenient for evening meals.

In the neighbouring market town of Peissenberg there is a greater range of restaurants and pubs. We can recommend the "**Gasthaus Sonne**" which offers a small menu with tasty Bavarian and German food. In the market town of Peiting the "**Zechenschenke**", the former canteen of the local pitch coal mine, serves well-cooked Bavarian and International food. The restaurant "**Zauberhütte**" offers very good seasonal meals. It is located on the outskirts of Peiting in a very tranquil setting. In the village of Polling it's worth stopping off at the restaurant and pub "**Klosterwirt**" opposite the monastery church if only to sit under the old chestnut trees in its beautiful traditional beer garden. The food is good too. The historic building of the "**Alte Ziegelei**" in Polling provides space not only for a beautiful beer garden and restaurant but also for a large exhibition area where legendary premium car brands such as Ferrari, Lamborghini, Maserati and Mercedes are displayed. The district capital Weilheim has several good restaurants and pubs, such as the "**Oberbräu**" in the Obere Stadt offering Bavarian and Spanish cuisine, the Indian restaurant "**Avtar**" and the Italian Restaurant "**La Galleria**". In the picturesque walled town of Schongau we can recommend the "**Löwenhof**" where you can sit in the secluded inner courtyard, or the "**Lagerhaus**", which provides space not only for a restaurant, cocktail bar and café but also for a small nostalgic cinema. In the furniture shop "**Mobili**" located in the town centre you can sit amidst the stylish furnishings and enjoy small dishes and cakes. It's open only until 6pm.
